2014

Columbia Fruit Packers adds new Compaq cherry line with optical sorting to their existing apple packing facility.

McDougall and Sons opens a new apple packing facility in Baker Flats, Washington. This facility is over 550,000 square feet, and has been designed with innovation and efficiency in mind. From 15 loading docks to large windows and skylights, every facet of the structure has been engineered to maximize efficiency and keep workers happy and productive. KUKA robots help with palletization, and the GREEFA GeoSort machinery snaps dozens of photos of fruit to aid in grading, sorting and quality control.

McDougall and Sons purchased 800 acres of land to plant apple, pear and cherry trees - "Legacy Orchards".



2015

The Baker Flats facility is expanded to include new Unitec cherry lines with infrared technology to detect internal and external defects.

Double Diamond installed a new Compaq cherry sizing/sorting machine to detect internal and external defects.



2016

Double Diamond expands Quincy facility with 14 CA rooms each with a 1500 bin capacity. In addition 12,000 new packing bins were purchased to meet growing production needs.

McDougall and Sons expands automated packing technology and installs three dedicated machines.

Columbia Fruit Packers is working on the installation of a new apple line.
